11th May – « L'histoire sans fin » - Part 2 (1h30 min)

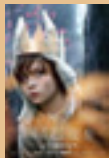
18th May – « L'histoire sans fin » - Part 3 (1h30 min)

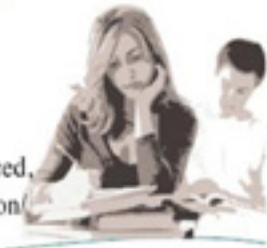

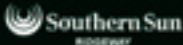
